Each candidate will conduct for no more than 20 minutes

**FINAL:** The candidates admitted to the Final will be **no more than 3** and they will conduct excerpt decided by the Jury from:

G. GRISEY: Vortex Temporum

C.TOGNI: Du Bleicher Geselle

J. WEIR: Blue-Green Hill

Each candidate will conduct for no more than 45 minutes
